



# COMPUTER PROJECT FOR WEST CAMEROON

# I. Context and problematic project

In Cameroon, the level of education is among the best in Central Africa. It is modeled on the French model. Yet the level computer is low for people leading a normal school. Some children complete their education without basic computer skills. At the age equivalent level in computing, an African child is very low compared that of a European child. This fact becomes obvious even to those who manage to enroll in a European university.

If today 0.4% of households Cameroonians come to have a modest home computer for their children, it is nevertheless in orphanages and poor families. Several associations and individuals are struggling to meet the needs of orphans in school supplies, lodging, and health foods. In schooling, the computer aspect is not taken into account. Yet there are workshops (mechanical, hairdressing, tailoring, masonry, carpentry, electricity, and electronics) in the technical guidelines.

## II. Project objectives

- Supplying six orphanages pilots in the region west of computers.
- Develop workshops for computer training (technical and general).
- Installed the desktop software such as Word, Excel for text input.
- Set technical software such as Autocad, PhotoPaint, visio to assist students in the technical session.
- The connection to the Internet for students at the college.

- Contact with students of technical schools of Dschang, Bafoussam Bandjoun, Mbouda, Banganté, Bafang to maintain in their work practice





## III Location of the Region of West Cameroon

Cameroon is located in Central Africa. Its population is currently estimated at around 40.6 inhabitants per km2. Its surface area to 475000km2.

Yaounde is the political capital, Douala is the economic capital.

The Western Region where we are originating for Bafoussam capital, third largest city. 12 orphanages in the region, 2,400 residents. Approximately 860 children attend school and learning.
